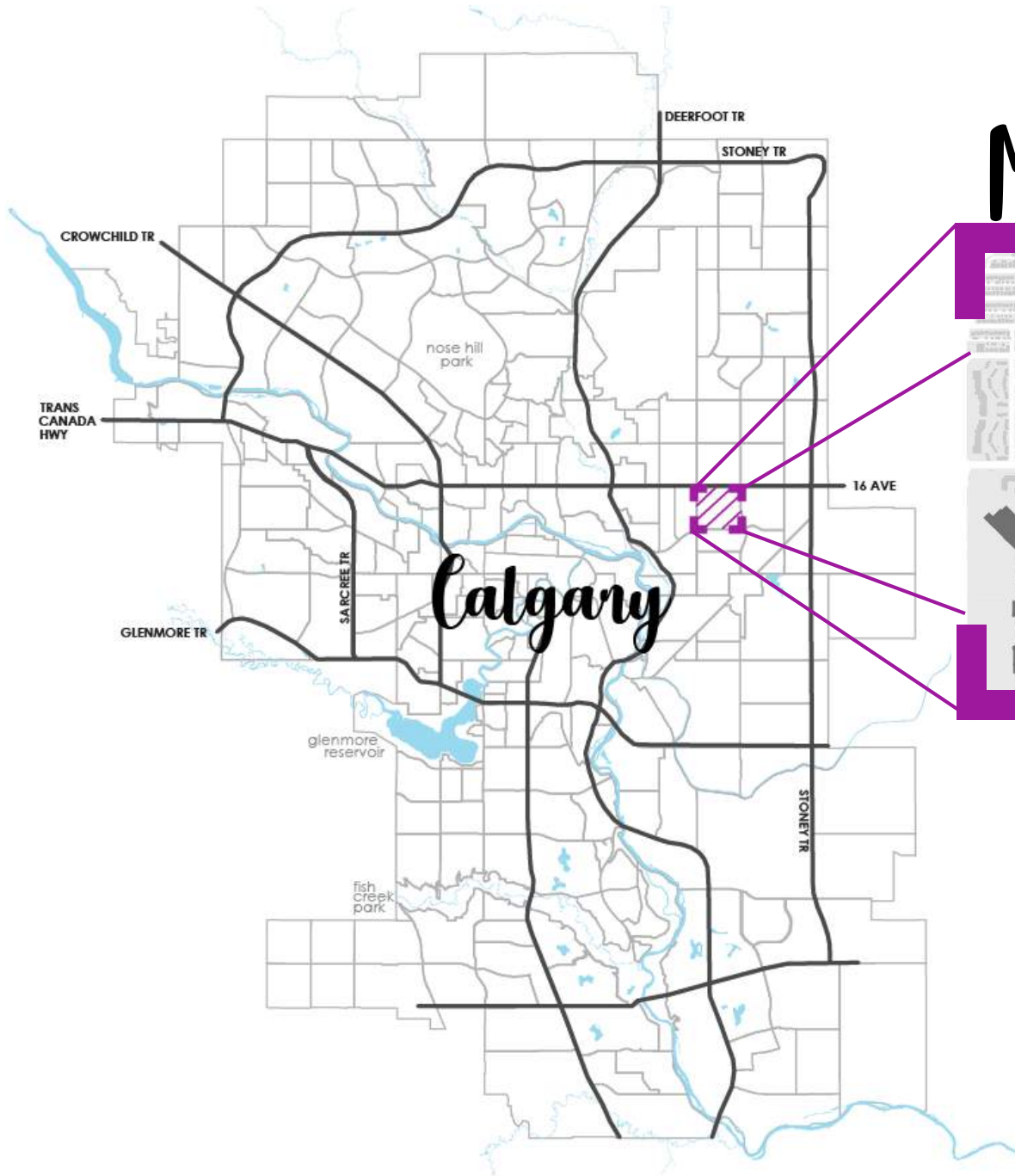

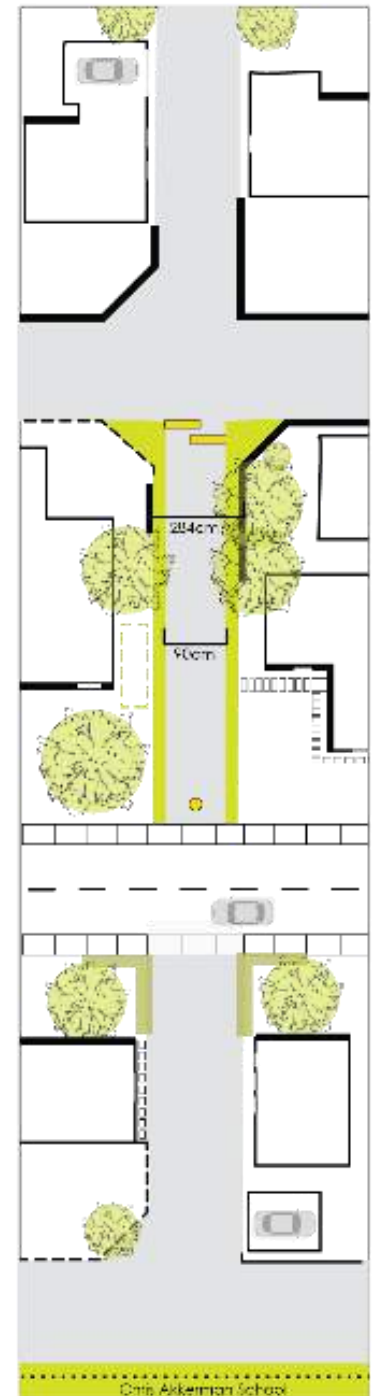

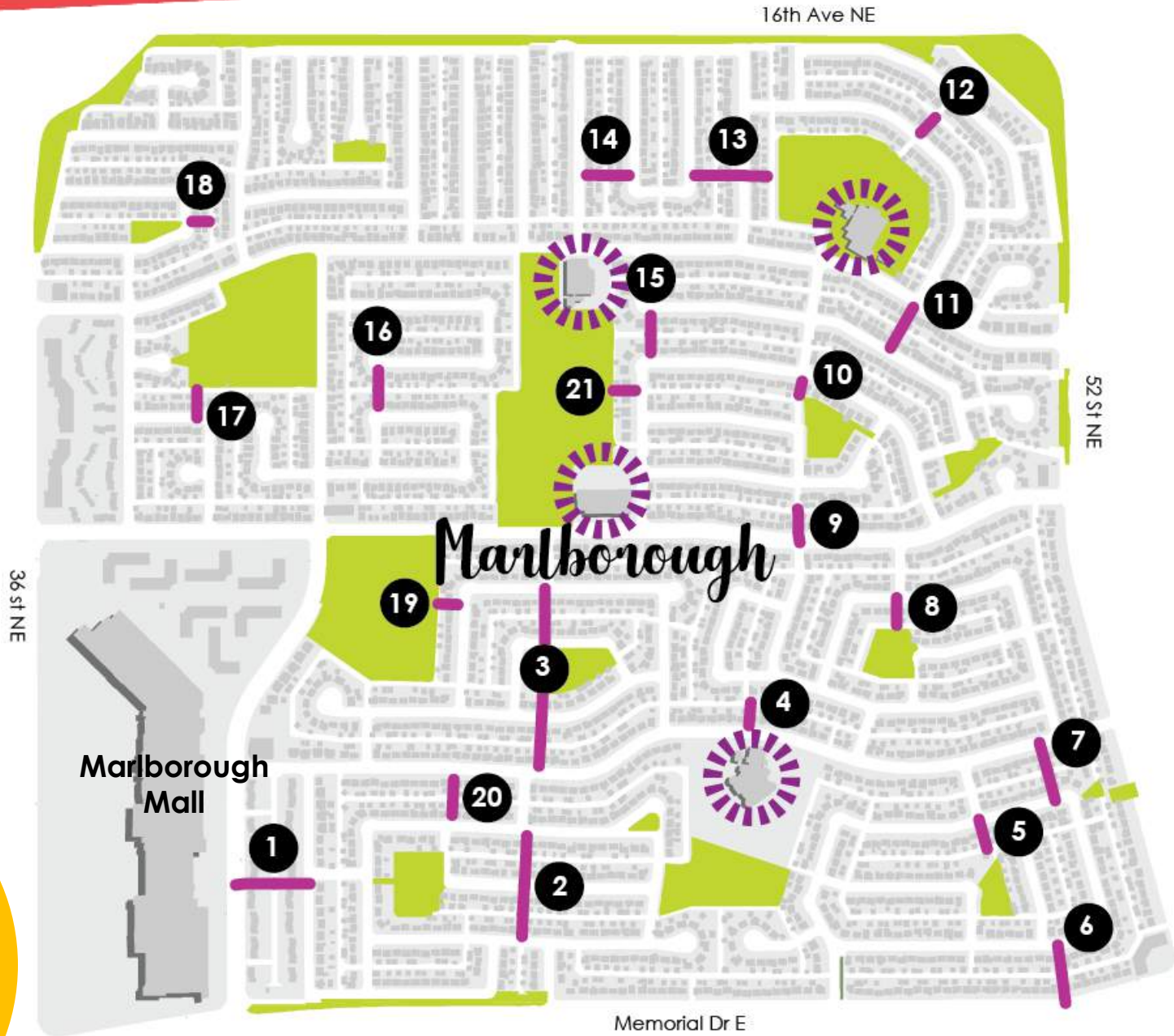
Network of engineered pathways designed to connect children to schools, families to parks and people to retail spaces.

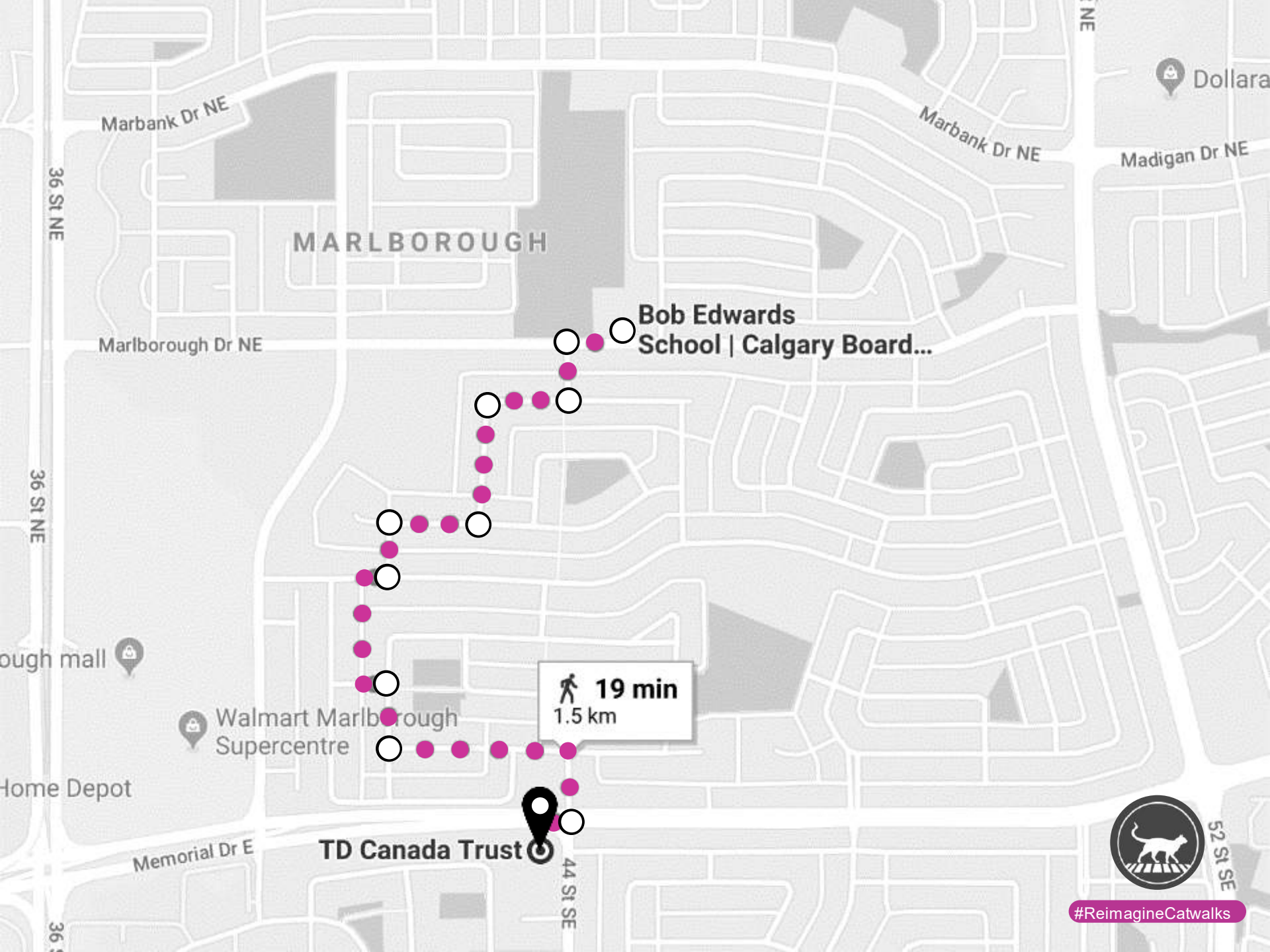

Age: 9

Hey, I'm Abdul. When I'm not in school you can find me playing in the park, running through the catwalks or riding my bike on the street. I know I should be careful, but sometimes I don't see cars and at times, they don't always see me.

How can we design safer streets for kids?

MICHAEL
Age: 18

I'm new to the Marlborough community - but despite this, I've already made some awesome friends here. I'm supposed to be meeting my new bud, Lee at his house which is next to a catwalk - but I'm a little lost. As a visually impaired person navigating a new environment, I have to use all other senses for guidance. Today, I'm finding it difficult to distinguish where the catwalk next to his home is. I'm lost, all the textures feel the same!

How can we design an easier environment to navigate?

JOHN
Age: 55

Hi there, I'm John! I've lived in Marlborough all my life as an able bodied person. I've recently had leg surgery - leaving me in need of a wheelchair. I used to walk to the mall for groceries - the trip would take 15 minutes - but today, its been more than 35 minutes!

Can you guess why it takes John longer in a wheelchair?

Oh, this is a little steep...



DORIS
Age: 75

I'm Doris. I've been a resident of Marlborough since 1966! I used to be able to walk through this community without a problem, but since I've gotten older, my joints hurt more! I love that the catwalks here provide me with shortcuts around the neighbourhood, but sometimes I find it difficult to cross the catwalks and the street.

How would you design better connections between street and sidewalk?

Its really dark in here.



CATALINA
Age: 34

Hello, I'm Catalina. I use the catwalks as a shortcut to my nearby daycare - they are really useful and time saving. I mainly use the catwalks during the day, when I have to drop off Luis. During the night, when it comes time to pick Luis up, these places are often dark, which prevent me from seeing where I am going. I'm scared I'm going to bump into something or trip, so instead I take the street route which takes 15 minutes longer!

"I've seen bikers actually turn around and bike through to see what's happening in here – overall a lot of positive attention for once



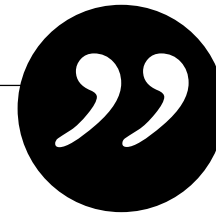
